The mission of the NVSBC is to insure the acquisition playing field is fair and level for veteran and service disabled veteran owned small businesses. We also train veteran business owners to be better more effective entrepreneurs.

Executive Order 13360, "Providing Opportunities for Service Disabled Veteran Businesses to Increase Their Federal Contracting and Subcontracting". Section 1 says "Heads of agencies shall provide the opportunity for service disabled veteran businesses to significantly increase the Federal contracting and subcontracting of such businesses". Section 2 states the duties of agency heads as follows:

- A. Develop a strategy to implement the policy.
- B. Make agency's strategy publically available and report annually to the Administrator of the Small business administration.
- C. Designate a senior level official who shall be responsible for developing and implementing the agency strategy.

We are hereby requesting a copy of your current strategy for insuring compliance with EO 13360 as well as the name, telephone number and email for the senior level official you have designated for implementing the agency strategy. We would like to meet with this official to discuss how the NVSBC and our members can assist you in complying with the Executive Order.
